

# Installation Manual

## IDASmio **RP** Filters

### Notes before the purchase and installation:

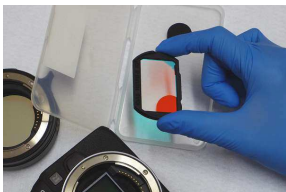
- 1) The IDASmio **RP** Filter can be attached to and detached from Canon **EOS RP** cameras (can NOT be used with EOS R or Ra).
- 2) This filter can NOT be used with any RF lens of which rear part is any farther extruded than the electrical contacts.

An example of an incompatible lens:

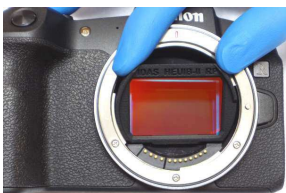


- 3) The optical path length change of this filter is ca.0.86mm.
- 4) When this filter is used between the lens and the camera, the back focus (BF) of the lens optically extends by about 0.86mm while the camera flange back (FB) relatively reduces by ca. 0.86mm.
- 5) When used with a camera that has not been modified to accommodate the abovementioned flange back change, you can fine focus on celestial objects, but the lens cannot be placed in the position originally designed for infinity shooting. As a result, the astigmatism and field curvature may change, possibly causing shot images to deteriorate.

### Installation to the camera:



1. Take out the RP Filter from the package.



2. Softly insert the RP Filter into the dented portion of the body mount.

**\*Cares must be taken so you won't damage the sensor and/or shutter membrane.**



3. Make sure that the filter is snugly fit with the dented shape.



4. Mount a lens or mount adapter while holding the camera body so the body mount become upwards.

When to remove, just follow the above instruction backwards.
